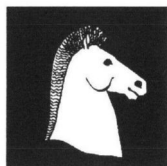

Culture and Environment in Inner Asia

Volume 1, *The Pastoral Economy and the Environment*. Pastoralism has shaped the steppe environment and been the basis of the indigenous economy of the grasslands of Inner Asia for more than two thousand years. This volume explores the pastoral economies developed under Russian, Mongolian and Chinese governance, their current trajectories, and their differing impact upon the steppe environment. It includes a unique collection of papers by scholars from the different sides of the international borders that divide Inner Asia.

Volume 2, *Society and Culture*, describes the enormous social change which the region has experienced in recent years, due to the advent of democracy in Russia and economic reforms in China. The book shows how the steppe environment is not pristine 'nature', but intermeshed with these processes, and with the distinctive, often religious, attitudes of the pastoral people.
